Procurement of Consultancy Services for Design and Supervision (Irrigation and Water Supplies Sectors) for Integrated Flood Resilience and Adaptation Programme (IFRAP)

The Government of Islamic Republic of Pakistan, represented by Government of Balochistan has received financing from the World Bank towards cost of the Integrated Flood Resilience and Adaptation Programme (IFRAP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds from this financing for consulting services for preparation of detailed designs, procurement assistance and supervision of civil infrastructure works (Irrigation and Water Supplies Sectors).

1. The Project Implementation Unit of IFRAP now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the requisite services as per the TORs. Consultants are encouraged to provide only materials that would be specific to the proposed services, and to avoid submitting generic promotional material. The shortlisting criteria are (i) Corporate Capacity (Core business and years of experience in same business for at least 10 years); ii) at least five (5) similar assignments completed in the last five years indicating the nature and scope of these assignments in areas of design, supervision, procurement, contract administration, quality assurance, environment, management planning, implementation of resettlement action plan; iii) the logistical capacity of firm and; iv) number of technically qualified staff (CVs not required at this stage)
2. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. The rationale for association with brief specialties to enhance the qualification shall be mentioned with broad job description of each member of association (JV and/or sub-consultant). In case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected. Interested consulting firms should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services.
3. Particular attention of the interested consultants is invited towards Section III - Governance, paragraphs 3.14 [Conflict of Interest], 3.16 and 3.17 [Consulting Services] of the World Bank’s Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers November 2020.
4. Expressions of Interest must reach the address mentioned below on or before Monday, January 15, 2024 at 1600 hours (PST).
5. A consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the World Bank’s Procurement Regulations.
